SAN SEBASTIAN

THE 17TH CENTURY MINING TOWN OF SAN SEBASTIAN, NESTLED IN THE HEART OF THE SIERRA MADRE MOUNTAINS IS ONE OF MEXICO'S LAST GREAT GETAWAYS



This beautiful, colonial village surrounded by aromatic pine forests dates back to 1605 and was made famous by its plentiful silver mines.

San Sebastian reached its glory in the 1700's during which time it was a highly prosperous town with a population reaching 30,000. Today with only 600 inhabitants, scattered examples of its magnificent historical grandeur can still be glimpsed.

Tumbling colonial architecture merges with a colorful village square, quaint cobblestone streets, passing mules and a sleepy way of life far removed from the rest of the world.

Your tour will include a guided walking tour of the town to visit such highlights as the 18th century church, colonial homes, old haciendas and the local coffee producers.

San Sebastian is a living museum untouched by time, making it an experience difficult to surpass.
